Alyona Karimova is a writer and translator, Head of the Tatarstan Writers' Union Translation Centre, Lecturer at the Gorky Literature Institute, Moscow Member of the Tatar PEN Center, expert of the Program for the Support of National Literatures of the Peoples of the Russian Federation. Graduated from the Physics Department of Kazan State University with a master's degree in physics and Higher Literature Courses at the Gorky Literary Institute, specializing in poetry. From 2003 to 2017, Head of Mark Zaretsky Literature Association at the Gorky Museum in Kazan. Worked as the editor-in-chief of the literature programs of the Marjani Foundation (Moscow), deputy editor-in-chief of the Idel magazine (Kazan), editor-in-chief of the USC corporate magazine Building the Fleet of a strong country.

Author of several poetry and children books. Took part in many Russian and foreign literature festivals and book fairs. Laureate of the State Award of the Republic of Tatarstan named after G.R. Derzhavin (2016, for the book of poems *Cold or Hot*), the Literature Award of Kazan named after M. Gorky (2007, for the books of poems *Another Dress*), the Literature Award named after S. Suleymanova (2023, for a collection of poetic translations from Tatar *Bird of the Heart*.

Winner of the International Literature Contest *Open Eurasia* (London, 2016) in the "poetic translation" nomination.
