

Vadim Polonsky is a Russian literary academic, who completed a PhD in 2008, became a professor at the Russian Academy of Sciences (RAN) in 2016, and an associate-member of the same Academy in 2019. Since 2014 he has been the main editor of the journal *RAN news: literature and language*, and is also the main editor of the complete academic collection of the works of A.M. Gorky.

Since 2015 he has been Director at the Institute of World Literature in RAN. He is a member of the President of the Russian Federation's Council for Russian Language, and the coordinated council of RAN professors. He joined the Expert Committee for the Higher Assessment Commission of the Russian Ministry of Higher Education regarding philology and art criticism from 2013-2016, and the experts' group on historico-philological studies for the Committee of Sciences of the Ministry of Higher Education. He is an honorary professor of the South-West (Chuntsin) University of the PRC, and received an honorary doctorate from the Institute of Literature of the National Academy of Sciences in Azerbaijan.

He is the author of more than 200 other works on the history and poetics of Russian literature in the 19th and 20th centuries, comparative literature and literary theory.
